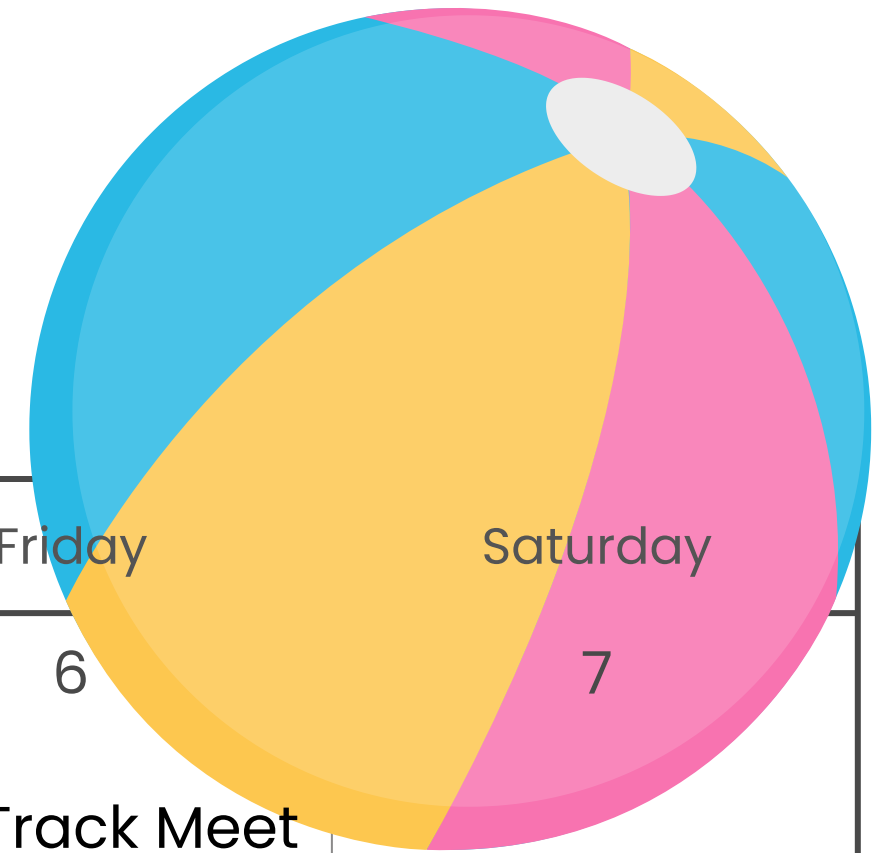

Bus will leave at 9am on both days.



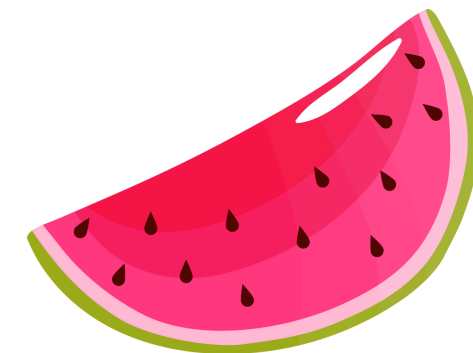

Forms for both of these will be coming home. We are hoping for nice weather but if it is raining, we will not be rescheduling these.

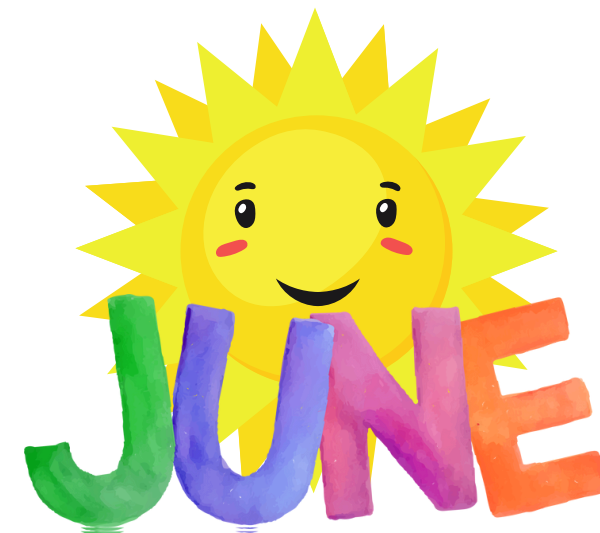
